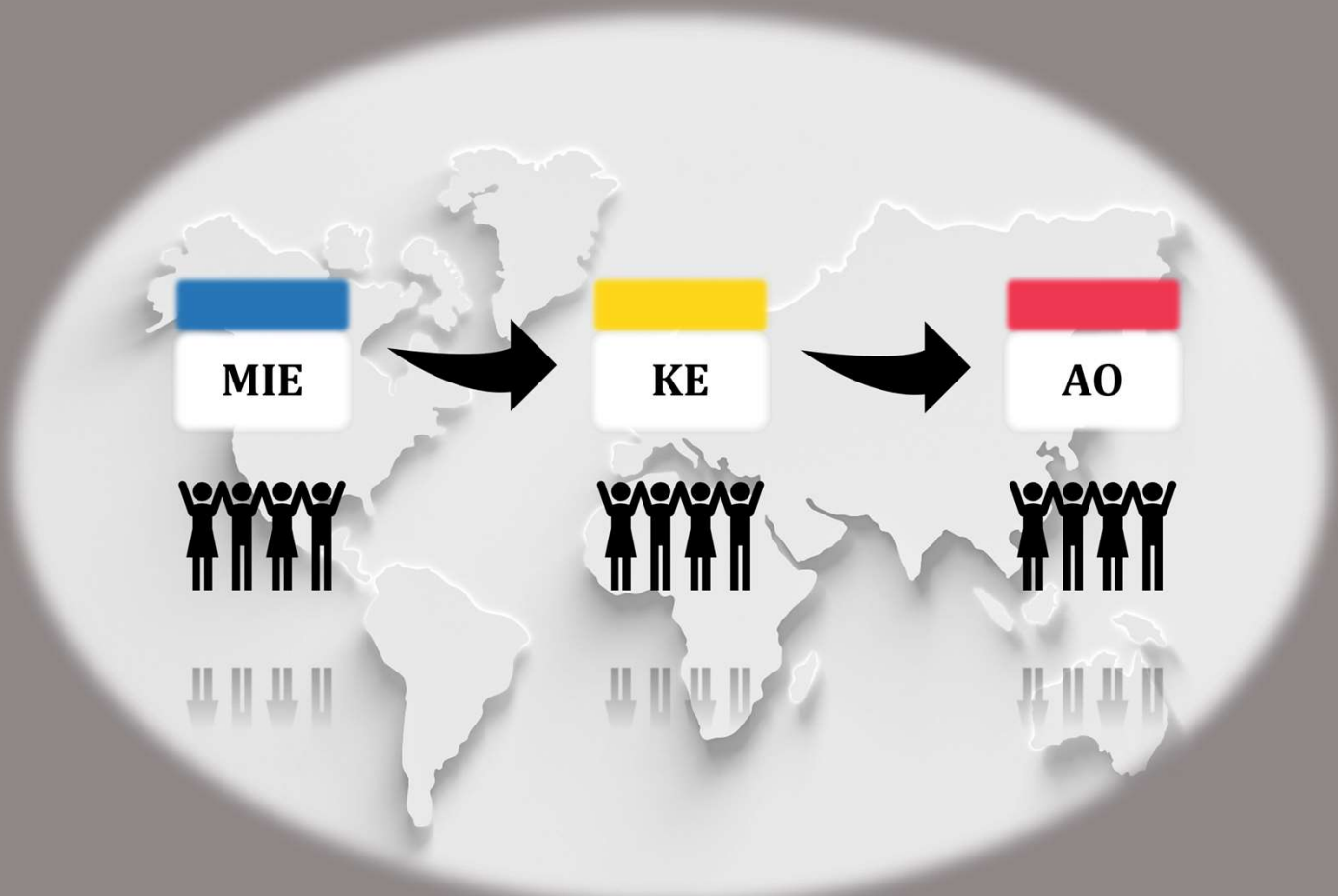

SAAOP

ADVERSE OUTCOME PATHWAYS (AOPs) – are a conceptual framework for portraying scientifically credible, causal linkages between perturbations of biological systems at the molecular, cellular, biochemical levels of organization to adverse effects to human or environmental health.

They are a knowledge synthesis and aggregation tool with a wide range of applications in environmental safety assessments of chemicals and radiation, environmental health, human medicine, life sciences research, and a range of regulatory and policy arenas that rely on science-based decision-making.

AOPs stored in the AOP knowledgebase (AOP-KB) and are assembled and disseminated through the AOP-Wiki (aopwiki.org).
